<i>Module Topic</i>	<i>Pre / Post-Module Assignments*</i>
<i>Course Introduction & Critical Reflexivity</i>	Pre: Complete 1-2 readings and answer up to 4 reflection questions. Post: Complete a reflective survey. Write 3-5 personal goals for the course.
<i>Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, & Justice Literacy</i>	Pre: Find a piece of media to examine through a DEI lens. Complete a reading and answer 2-3 reflection questions. Post: Complete a personal action plan for expanding DEI literacy.
<i>Empathetic Learning</i>	Pre: Complete a reading and submit a 2-3 sentence reflection. Read and bring a worksheet to class. Post: Begin reviewing and working on the final project.
<i>Centering & Decentering</i>	Pre: Complete 2 readings and answer 2-3 reflection questions for each. Post: Continue working on the final project.
<i>Generative Conflict</i>	Pre: Watch a video (~25 min.) and complete a reading. Answer 2-4 reflection questions. Post: Continue working on the final project.
<i>Anti-Oppressive Ethos & Design Justice</i>	Pre: Complete 3 short readings and answer 2-3 reflection questions. Post: Continue working on the final project.
<i>Final Project</i>	The final project will be crafting and submitting an Equity Ethos. Read more about an Equity Ethos here. The final project is a course completion requirement and may be submitted in various mediums (writing, video recording, slide deck).
